THOUGHTS FROM PHIL

The pandemic, the fear, the uncertainty, the loss of income, the school debate (stay home or go to school), the deaths... these are reasons to feel anxious, fearful, overwhelmed, at a loss for what to do, and depressed. I have felt some of these same feelings over the last many months, and I will admit that. I don't like myself very much when those feelings come over me, because I am a man of faith in Jesus Christ, and I have the Holy Spirit of God living within me. There is only one solution to resolving these feelings of being put under great pressure: reading God's Holy Word. Let me recommend 2 Corinthians 1:3-11 for such a time as this. These words from our Lord (through Paul's writings) have given me great comfort, and they will give you this same comfort as well.

A few highlights: (New King James version) Father of mercies and God of all comfort (verse 3). Who comforts us in all our tribulations (Greek word means "to be put under great pressure") (verse 4). So that (here's our answer why we're put under great pressure) we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble with the same comfort we ourselves are comforted by God (verse 4).

In Asia, Paul was so greatly pressured that he felt the death sentence upon him, with no way to escape it, beyond his own ability to do anything about it (verse 8) Oh, but then verse 9 shows up... "Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead!" Then in verse 10 he states, "who delivered us...who does deliver us... who will still deliver us." What a wonderful God we serve, for He is always looking after us!! So, where is your focus during these days of pressure? He's allowed these days to come to us so that we wouldn't trust in ourselves, but rather look to and trust in Him alone! Do you?

Be comforted with His words and His presence!!!
